### **Your Grid Iron**

# **Weekly Rules**

- Each week constitutes a new pool.
- You may play as many or as few weeks as you like but you are allowed only one entry per week per name.
- If playing multiple sheets use different usernames. (Example: A-Dogg, and A-Dogg 2)
- Each entry costs 7 points which goes into the pot paid to that week's winner(s).
- Note, however, that 2 points of each player's entry is reserved for an overall award of 300 points to be given to the player with the most wins at the end of the regular season.
- The rest of the points go towards the costs of maintaining the website, and other costs associated with running the football pool.
- To enter, fill in the entry form by making your pick for each game. (The goal is to pick the winning teams.)
- You will also be asked to guess the total points scored in the Monday Night Football game (or whatever the last scheduled game of that week is). This will be used as a tiebreaker.
- The winner for each week will be the player with the most correct picks. In the event of a tie, the player who guessed closest to the actual point total of the tiebreaker game will win. Should any players still be tied after applying the tiebreaker, the pot will be divided equally among those players.
- For the tiebreaker, it does not matter if your point total is over or under the actual score total. It is only the difference that counts. Please note that we hand out sheets at the beginning of the season, and all tiebreaker games have been chosen. This means if there is a schedule change the original selected game stays the original selected game.

## **Monday Squares**

- There is a one-time fee of 50 points which covers 21 Monday football games. Your box stays in the same spot as you signed up for and will be issued one set of numbers every week. Your numbers will be available every week printed or online.
- Pay outs are as follows HALF TIME 100 points, and FINAL SCORE 100 points.

### **33 POOL**

- This pool runs the whole season and is 50 points.
- 33 pool is a 32-player weekly pool that requires no skill.
- Each week you will be given a random team.
- If your team that week's final score is 33 you will be given 1 win.
- The player with the most times getting 33 at the end of the season wins. If there is a tie the pot will be split.
- This pool will pay 1440 points.

#### **Survivor Pool**

- This pool is separate from the weekly picks pool. If you choose to participate, you must enter during the start of the 1st game of the season for survivor 1 or week 6 for survivor 2. The entry fee is 25 points per entry.
- The pool runs over the entire regular season. Each week, you
  must pick one team among those playing that you think will
  win its game. You can use each team only once.
- The goal of the survivor pool is to outlast your fellow players. If your team wins, you survive and continue to the next week. If your team loses, or ties you are eliminated.
- Note that if you do not make a pick for a given week, it counts as a loss. In the event all active players are eliminated in a single week, those players will be reinstated and continue to the next week.

- When only one player remains, he or she wins the pot. If more than one player survives to the end of the regular season, they will split the pot equally.
- A split is possible if all players agree to a split.

# **Digit Pool**

- This pool is a no skill pool. All players front 25 points and then are given a random team.
- As your team finishes a game week to week use the last digit in your final score and you can remove it from the numbers 0-9. For example, if your teams final score is 28 you drop the number 8 and would need the remaining 9 numbers to win.
- This pool will pay out 600 points.
- To win, be the first team to use all numbers 0-9. This means if 2 teams in the same week, end with using all the numbers the FIRST game that ends wins.
- If there is no winner by the end of the season, then the teams with the most digits used will go to a tie breaker by adding up all digits used.

### **Final Note**

- All players pick weekly, and survivor will be posted by 1 hr. after first kick off unless otherwise unable to.
- There will be no picks accepted after the deadline as the new week's pick sheet will be posted.
- If you see any problems with your picks after they are posted, you must notify us within 24 hours after the first kickoff.
- Note the only corrections that can be made are turned in sheets, if you made an error online those picks are locked.
- If you do not touch base with either Chris or Aaron by the deadlines given above, we cannot go back and fix any picks, this is your responsibility to check your picks.
